Welcome to Fetch Fraternity at Brentwood Animal Campus!

A typical day here at Fetch...

Drops offs are from 6:00-8:00AM. When your dog arrives, they are immediately let outside in one of our play yards, so they can go to the bathroom and get a little bit of energy out before playing with all their friends. They are then settled into their kennels until all staff members arrive.

* All **"New Pledges"** are required to arrive between 6:00-7:30AM so they can be slowly introduced to the pack before playtime begins. At 8:00AM, all new members are walked out to the field first, so they can become accustomed to their surrounds before they are introduced to the pack.

At 8:00AM, our staff walks the dogs out to Huntzie field (big yard) or to our small yard based on temperments and owners preferences. At this time, everybody is ready to swim, play, and make new friends! Our facility offers a fenced in, 1 ½ acre yard with a pond for your dog to run and splash in. This yard is also equipped with several timeout pens, if a dog is playing a little too rough or is being short tempered. You will be notified of their behavior during the day through our daily report cards that we send home with you.

The pups play in Huntzie field until 9:30. We then walk the dogs inside to get dried off and to take a short break until 9:45AM. They then play together inside and in the play pens adjacent to our building from 9:45-11:00AM.

11:00 – 1:00PM means naptime! Each K9 has their own 4x6 ft. kennel with blankets, fresh water, and music. You are more than welcome to bring a lunch, toys, or snacks from home.

*Feel free to call and inquire about how your pup is doing at anytime and we will get back to you as soon as possible. We also take pictures daily and upload them to our Animal Campus Facebook page so you can see what a great time they are having!

After the dogs have their nap, we are ready for "Round 2"! Once again we go out to Huntzie Field from 1:00 - 3:00PM for more play time. At 3:00PM, all dogs are brought back inside and again are towed off to ensure a "dry" ride home. Pick ups start at 3:30PM, and you should expect your K9 to be a happy, tired, and well loved dog!

FAQs

How do I get started at Fetch Fraternity?

The first step is to get us a copy of your pet's vet records. After that, we can sign up your pup for their trial day. You will need to complete several forms regarding general information about your dog, as well as provide proof of vaccinations from your vet clinic.

Is there an evaluation fee?

There is not a separate evaluation fee, and trial days are at no charge. We introduce dogs slowly, one by one, on the first day to make your dog's stay safe and comfortable.

Are reservations required?

Yes! 24 hour advance notice is required. (We recommend as soon as possible because we fill up fast!) Unless you have already reserved "Your Days", we have a first come first serve policy. This is to ensure we are properly staffed.

How many hours a day is Fetch in Huntize Field?

An average of 3 1/2 hours per day is spent out in the field. (From 8:00-9:30AM and 1:00-3:00PM). We do share the field with our boarding facility here at Brentwood Animal Campus. Therefore the Dorms and Fetch dogs are in the field at alternating times throughout the day. Fetch dogs then have an additional 1 1/2 hours of playtime alternating between their indoor play area and the play pens adjacent to our building.

Is the pond safe for dogs?

Our pond is treated with an organic dye which is environmentally safe. It is not harmful to animals- frogs are local residents in spring and summer.

Do you have naptime/rest time?

Yes, every day from 11:00-1:00pm. We provide blankets, fresh water, and music. You are welcome to pack a lunch for your pup. (We provide the bowls!) We also end the day quietly with rest time at 3:30 PM.

What do you do for inclement weather?

In the event of lightning, thunder, heavy rain, excessive heat, extremely cold weather (depending on the wind chill) or any hazardous field conditions, we do not go outside to the field, but enjoy our inside play areas instead!

When can puppies come to daycare?

Puppies are allowed to come to daycare as soon as they are up to date on all of our required vaccinations!
